3 - COMPETITION:

A. Characteristics

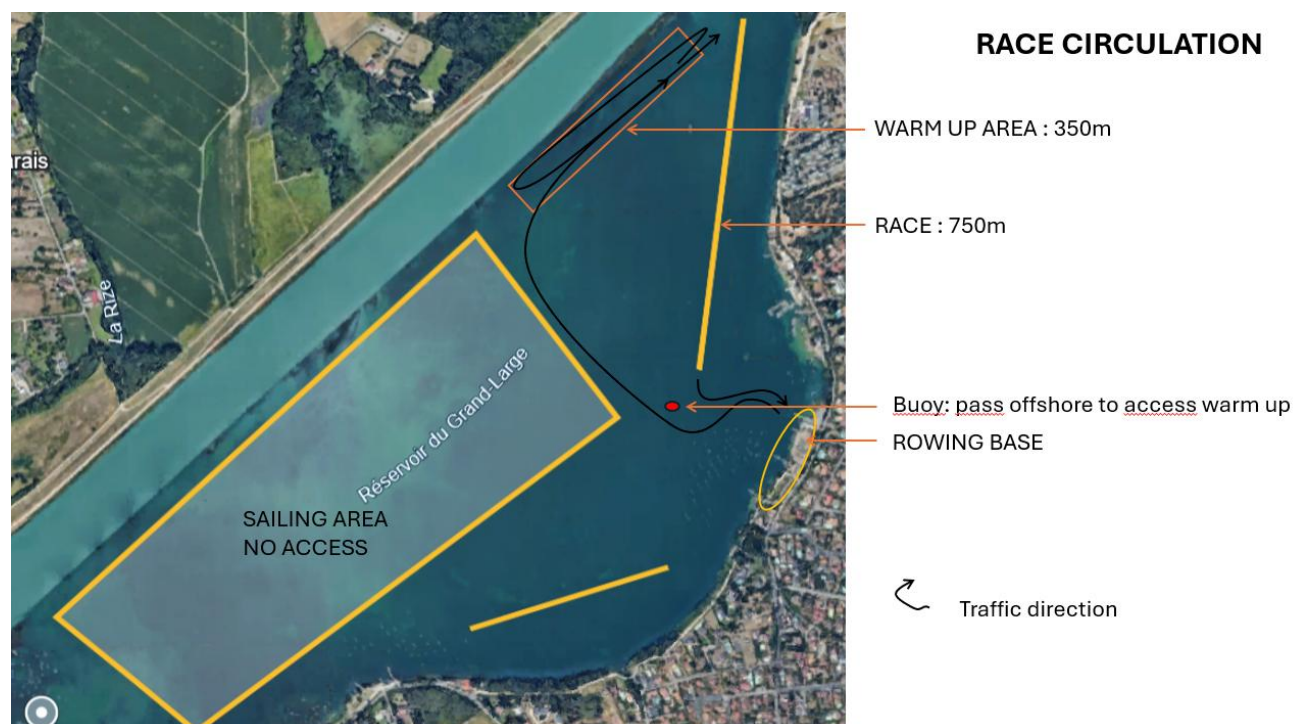
- Competitor categories: Open > 18 years - Masters > 27 years.
- First race against the clock, classification by time.
- Qualifying laps in dual races: 1 against 1.
- Each category follows a specific selection route depending on the number of entrants.

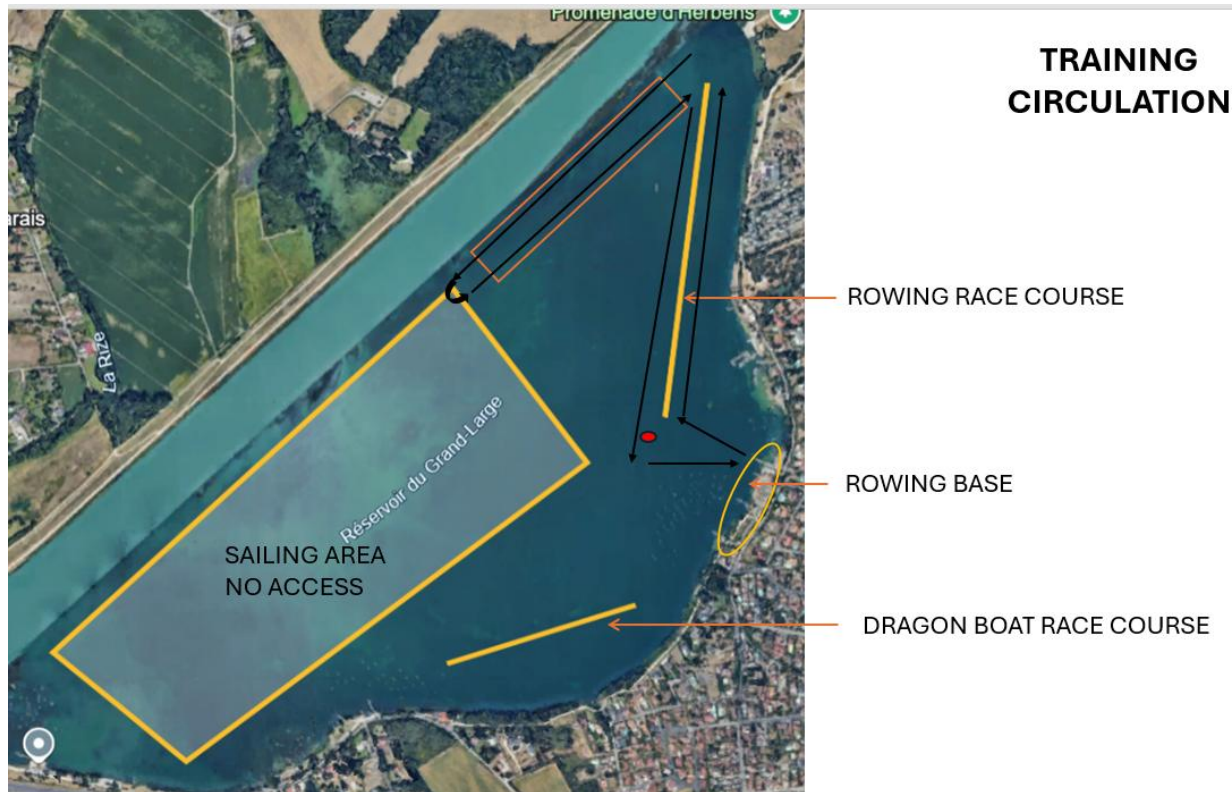
B. Race

- Race distance : 750m
- Starts not held
- 1 boat on each side of the line of buoys
- Race referees: 3 positions
 - Start referee: Starter
 - Referee at 350m with safety boat in fixed position, who can intervene on the race Race in the event of a problem.
 - Finish referee with stopwatch, who validates the races.

D. Training

- Authorized training sessions on 24 July from 16:00 to 18:00 and on 25 July from 8:00 to 9:00, reserved for participating rowers.
- Failure to comply with the traffic plan during training will result in a warning to the crew.

4 - MATERIAL:

A. Insurance

- All crew members taking part with their own equipment must insure it. The organizing committee declines all responsibility.
- Rental equipment is insured by the hiring club.
- All competition equipment must be stored in the boathouse overnight.
- No night-time security service.

B. The numbers are supplied by the organizer. Each crew keeps its number for the duration of the competition.

5 - COMMITMENTS:

- Must be completed on the official Eurogames website: <https://lyon2025.com>
- All events are offered in Open and Master
- Boat categories: skiff 1X, double 2X, quadruple sculls 4X, coxless fours 4-, eights 8+
- Crews: men, women, mixed and non-binary
- Coxswains: no minimum weight required

6 - JUDGE:

Referees will be appointed by the President of the Regional Referees Committee.

The jury may, in accordance with the regatta code, refuse to allow a crew to embark if it considers that the boat does not meet the minimum safety conditions.

The president of the jury, in agreement with the organizing committee, has the right to modify the race distance according to external conditions.

Crews must be able to show proof of identity (physical or electronic) when embarking and disembarking.

Crews receiving 2 warnings will be disqualified.

7 - MEDICAL AND EMERGENCY SERVICES:

Provided by:

- On the water: 3 safety boats
- On the ground: UDPS team, on the club premises (first-aid post on site)

8 - DELEGATES' MEETING:

It will take place on 25/07/2025 at 8:00 am.

- Race information and weather reports will be sent to delegates and skippers.
- The participation of one representative per boat is recommended.
- Any modification to an entry (withdrawal and/or change) must be made during the delegates' meeting, in writing on the official form, and to the president of the Jury during the meeting.
